




Primary

- Original written works (i.e. poems, diaries, court records, interviews, surveys, and original research/fieldwork)
- Research published in scholarly/academic journals.




SOURCES IN ACADEMIC LEARNING

Sources are those that describe or analyze primary sources

Secondary

- Reference materials (i.e. dictionaries, encyclopedias, textbooks)
- Books and articles that interpret, review, or synthesize original research/fieldwork.




SOURCES IN ACADEMIC LEARNING

<u>Used to organize and locate secondary and primary sources</u>

Tertiary

- Indexes (provide citations that fully identify a work)
- Abstracts (summarize the primary or secondary sources)
- Databases (usually include abstracts and resources)

HIERARCHY OF SOURCES



- Information from an individual
- ➤ Information from crowdsourced information (i.e. Wikipedia)
- ➤ Information from an organization
- ➤ Information from a governmental organization
- ➤ Information from a scholarly source
