Pasco Discovery Coalition - Logic Model



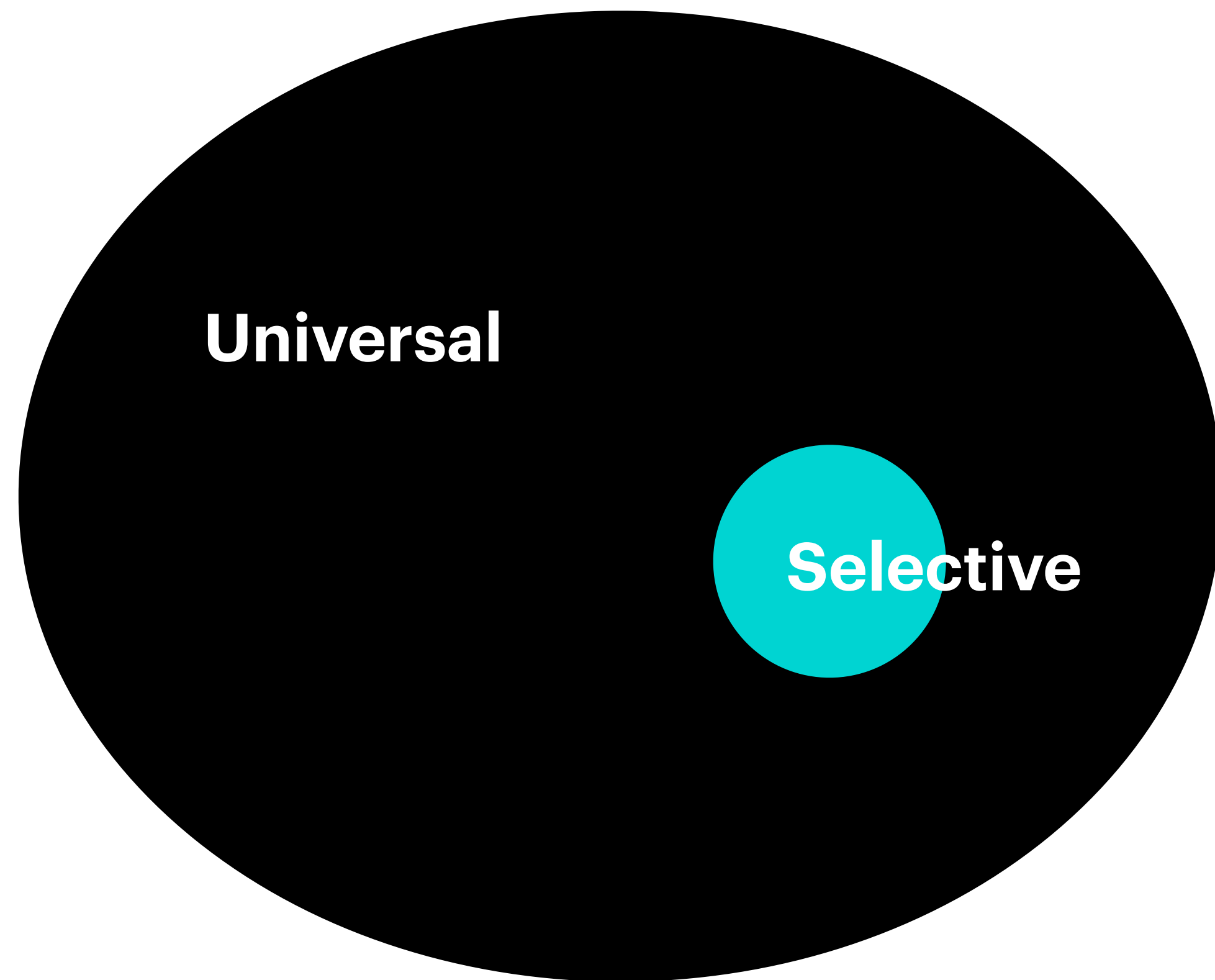

Interventions should be built on research-based knowledge of human development

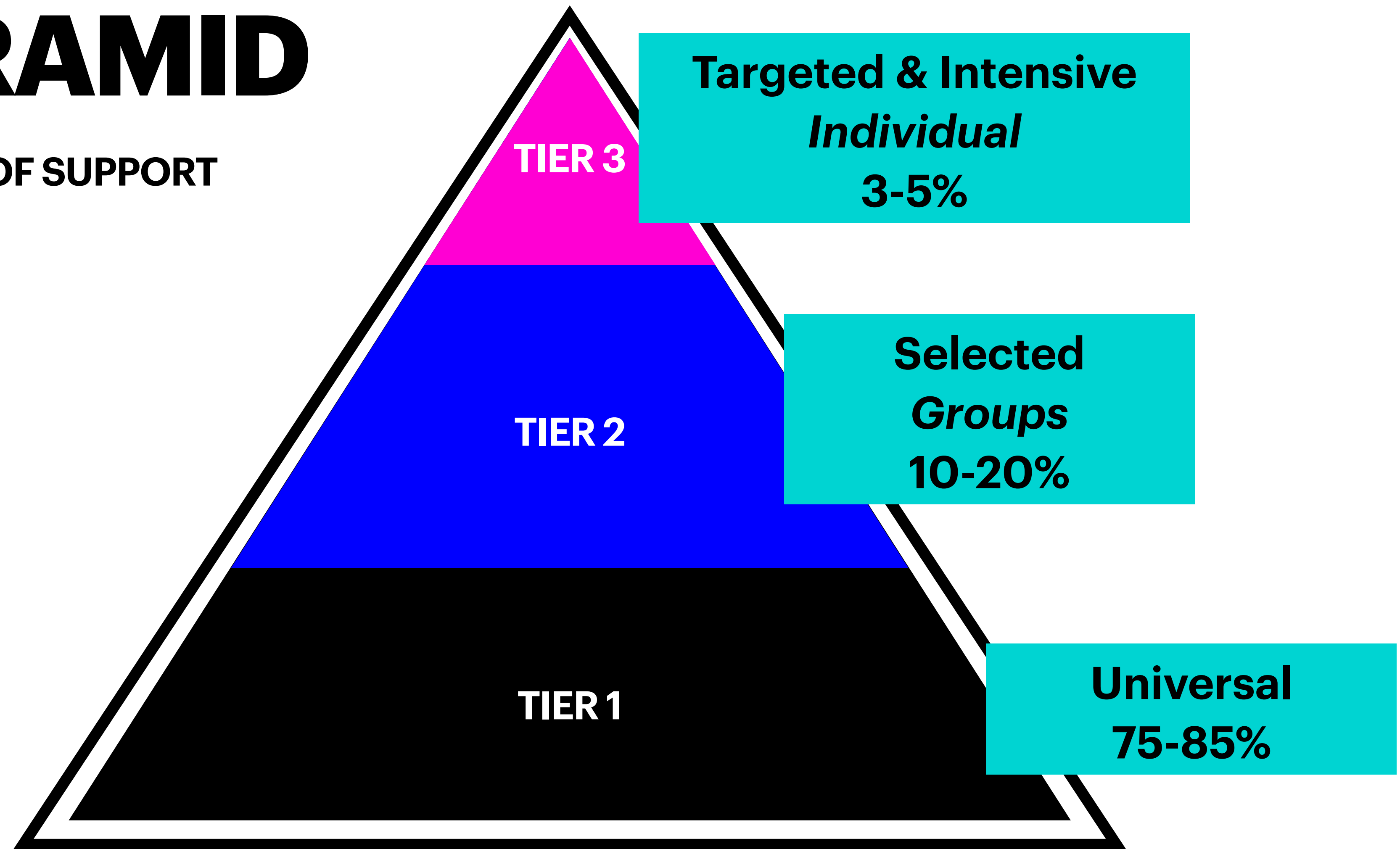

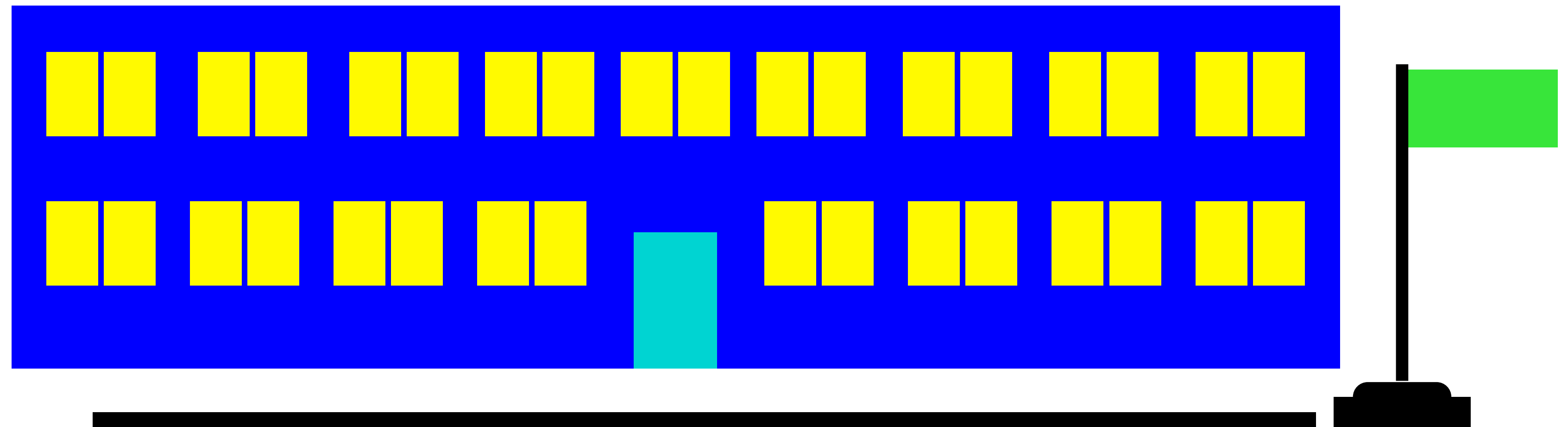
